WMOF2018 will be one of the most significant events in Ireland in 2018 and we look forward, along with all the families and pilgrims who join us, to celebrating love and family life at this joyous event in August.

Families from all over the world have registered for WMOF2018! Of the over 25,000 people already registered to attend the Pastoral Congress, 10,000 are from overseas and the remaining being registrations from within Ireland. We hope to welcome between 10,000 – 12,000 international visitors to Ireland - this would be the largest international attendance at a World Meeting of Families gathering.

THE PASTORAL COMMUNITY have organised a bus to take pupils and teachers from the Primary Schools and Post-Primary Schools from the six parishes to go to the World Meeting of Families Congress on **Thursday 23rd August** to experience the International Speakers and Families from throughout the world who are attending. This should be a unique opportunity for the children & young people to experience other cultures who are visiting Ireland. They will also be accompanied by other adults from each of the parishes in a supervisory position including clergy and chaplains.

You will need a ticket for the Final Mass in Phoenix Park.

Your tickets will be sent to you closer to the event.

Every adult and child attending will need a ticket. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections. It is not possible to apply for tickets for both Phoenix Park and Knock, as both events will take place on the same day. You may only apply for one of these events.

Your tickets will be sent by email in the form of a 'print at home' ticket. This will include travel information, along with details of how to get to your section of Phoenix Park for the Final Mass.
