When St. Anne's Primary school closes on 31st October, responsibility for the building will revert to St. MacNissi's Educational Trust as Trustee of the School. The Education Authority and Trust will ensure that the building is secure. Under School Building Regulations, the Department of Education is entitled to recover grants paid towards the development of the school estate, e.g additional accommodation and significant upgrades to facilities. To meet this liability, the Trust may need to dispose of the site. As is required by charity legislation, any surplus generated by the disposal is ringfenced for supporting Catholic education in the diocese.


