DAY 1: Monday – ARRIVAL AND TRANSFER TO LISIEUX

Our flight departs Belfast International Airport for Paris with Easyjet at 2pm. Transfer to three star Grand Hotel de l'Esperance (or similar) in Lisieux (nearly three hours' drive). We will be staying here for three nights on a half-board basis. Check in and dinner.

Day 2: Tuesday – *LISIEUX*, *ST THERESE*

Breakfast at 8.30am. Gather at hotel entrance. Visit the Carmelite convent where the "Little Flower" spent her life as a nun. Venerate her tomb in the Basilica and celebration of Mass. Free time for lunch. Mid-afternoon visit to her childhood home at Les Buisonnetts. Here we will be able to view some of her clothing and personal objects. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 3: Wednesday – BAYEUX, OMAHA BEACH

After breakfast we will take the coach to Bayeux. Mass in the neo-gothic Bayeux Cathedral, original home of the famous tapestry. View the tapestry (depicting events leading up to the Norman conquest of England) in the town museum. Free time for lunch. Continue to Omaha beach on the Normandy coast. This was one of the beaches used by the Allies on D-Day. Return to Lisieux in the late afternoon. Free time to revisit the Basilica of the Little Flower. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 4: Thursday – MONT SAINT-MICHEL, SAINT-MALO

After breakfast check out and transfer to Mont Saint-Michel. This island (accessible by bridge) has an important sanctuary dedicated to St Michael the Archangel. The 8th century monastery is a UNESCO world heritage site. Mass in the Abbey church. Tour of the principal monuments on the island. Free time for lunch. Continue to Hotel Kyriad Prestige in Saint-Malo, where we will stay three nights on a half board basis. Dinner and overnight.

Day 5: Friday – SAINT-MALO, DINARD

After breakfast, visit the centre of historic Saint-Malo. This walled city is the most visited place in Brittany. Mass in the medieval Cathedral, a national monument which contains the tomb of Jean de Châtillon, first bishop of the city. Free time for lunch. Afternoon visit to Dinard (45 minutes' drive), a popular seaside resort with beautiful villas and cafes. Return to Saint-Malo in the late afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 6: Saturday – ST COLUMBAN'S DAY EVENTS IN SAINT-COULOMB

Today's programme will follow the St Columban's day events in Saint-Coulomb, the place where the Irish saint and his companions landed on the continent at the beginning of their epic missionary journey. More details to follow. The events will include lunch and dinner with other participants in the gathering. We will also visit the nearby Valley of the Saints which features almost 100 enormous statues of the Saints of Brittany, including St Columbanus.

Day 7: Sunday – *RETURN FROM NANTES TO DUBLIN*

Relaxed morning in Saint-Malo. Check out at 11.30 am and transfer to Nantes Airport (two hours' drive) for our 4pm Aer Lingus flight to Dublin.
