Update on Repairs to Most Holy Redeemer

The one item of good news is that a new burglar alarm has been fitted. The next of the news is simply frustrating.

After having waited for six months for the installation of gas we welcomed the contractors who started their work and ceased almost immediately on discovering that their map of what was under the surface of Lyle Road was incomplete. For fear of cutting electric cables, pipes etc they decided that the road would have to dug by hand rather than mechanically, to do this they have secured the closure of the road on February 14th. In the belief that the gas supply would have been installed the plumber had been engaged to fit a new boiler on the 7th February. Not wanting to incur further delay it has been decided to keep to this date.

When the gas eventually flows and the boiler is producing heat the process of drying out the church can begin so that the electrical lighting work may be safely carried out and internal plaster work be dealt with.

This is a much as I know and I will keep parishioners informed of future progress and catastrophes as they occur. Fr J Gunn.
