Directions:

Leave Athlone bypass at J8, follow signs to town centre. After KFC on left, turn left at roundabout, then left again on road to Clonbonny, with Aldi on the left. Drive 5km to T junction. Turn left and park by bog railway crossing. Gather at 10.30am.

The pilgrim walk starts from Clonbonny to arrive in Clonmacnoise for Annual Pattern Day at 3.00pm.
Bus back to Shannonbridge after Mass.
